

## NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

The health and wellbeing of our exhibitors as well as of students and parents attending our expos are ISN's the top priority. ISN has been closely monitoring the guidelines and updates from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and World Health Organization (WHO) regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19).

In response to the coronavirus pandemic, ISN has created strict precautionary measures to adapt and meet the new health and safety concerns. The key planning considerations below are based on WHO's Public Health for Mass Gatherings: Key Considerations.


- Our event timings will be longer. Instead of having 3-hour event, we will have a 5-hour event (depending on the city) and limit the number of students inside the ballroom to ensure effective and strict crowd management.
- Meeting layouts will be organized to implement physical distancing and to actively reduce overcrowding in the venue, throughout the day.
- ISN will continue pre-registering students to a specific time slot to avoid overcrowding and to minimize foot traffic and flow for attendees going in and out of the event hall. A time slot with a maximum number of people is set up to split visitors throughout the day to minimize the transmission of infectious diseases.
- Requirement of travel and health declaration. Registration of students will include questions that will determine their current health status and/ or any possible previous exposure to COVID-19 patients. Any student/ parent who will not meet our safety criteria will not be given tickets and not be allowed to attend the expo.
- There will only be one entry point and one exit point at the event hall.
- All expo participants are required to wear face shields and face masks at all times during the event.
- The hotel venue will provide body temperature checks at the entrance of the event hall. A body temperature of 37.5 Celsius or 99.5 Fahrenheit and higher will not be allowed to enter the event hall.
- Social distancing measures will strictly be followed between the exhibitor's table and the students.
- Each exhibitor table will have an alcohol-based sanitizer. The exhibitor and the student are required to sanitize first before and after interacting.
- There will be breaks in between (every two hours) to allow the hotel staff to sanitize and disinfect the event hall.
- Depending on the local rules of each country/ city, the layout or format of the event might differ. There is a possibility that the expo will be turned to different seminars. A formal announcement will be made prior to travel to prepare the exhibitors and students.
- ISN and the exhibitors will follow the rules and regulation of high schools that we are going to visit.
